We do this by providing the poorest of the poor with life-giving aid, including food, clothing, shelter, medical assistance, education, and spiritual support.

HISTORY Serving Hands International (SHI) was founded in 1982 as Terrence and Barbara Caster's response to the call of Mother Teresa for everyone to help those who are "unwanted, unloved and uncared for."

SHI began by providing basic necessities to people in poverty, both in the U.S. and Mexico. More than 28 years later the Casters have brought together family, friends, and other compassionate individuals to serve people in poverty throughout the world.

- Over 1,500 received medical and dental services
